Sales at events MUST track every item sold, amount paid, and method of payment!

The "or else" doesn't bear contemplation

- Take out 5.5% of all sales for taxes
- Take out cost of <u>new merchandise</u> to pay off "loan"
- Take out cost of consignment merchandise
- What's left is net profit




